



**GUIDELINES FOR THE
ALABAMA VOCAL ASSOCIATION
FRANCES P. MOSS CHORAL DIRECTOR'S AWARD**

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS AWARD:

1. A nominee must have taught choral music in ALABAMA schools for a minimum of fifteen (15) years.
2. A nominee should have established and/or maintained a choral program that is recognized as one of quality and high standards.
3. A nominee must have actively participated in Alabama Vocal Association sponsored events.
4. A nominee must have made contributions to the Alabama Vocal Association with positive support and encouragement.
5. A nominee may not be a current AVA board member.

ANY AVA MEMBER MAY NOMINATE A DIRECTOR FOR THIS AWARD BY:

1. Submitting nomination form (F-27) of the AVA handbook to the Alabama Vocal Association President, of the director's accomplishments.
2. Submitting written nomination by January 31st to the AVA President.

SELECTION OF A DIRECTOR FOR THIS AWARD:

1. The entire Alabama Vocal Association Board will vote on submitted nominations at the January board meeting.
2. The award will be presented at the All-State concert.
3. The award may, but does not necessarily have to be given each year.

The award will be in the form of a plaque in honor of Dr. Francis P. Moss for her many contributions to elevating the art of choral music in the state of Alabama.
